

# Tartan, suspension design Ludovica+Roberto Palomba 2015

Tartan is the unmistakable design characteristic of Scottish woollen kilts with its perpendicular criss cross pattern generating ever changing geometric motifs. The Tartan suspension lamp has a blown glass diffuser made using the technique of mouth blowing into a mould with a design engraved in it, enriching it with lines and folds echoing the weave of Scottish cloth and a graphic play of light and shadow. The acid etching technique used on the surface of the glass also produces a sensation of material softness which brings fabric to mind. Materially

rich with an attractive personality, Tartan diffuses a warm, suffused light into the environment filtered with mattglass and also ensures good direct lighting in a downwards direction.

## Description

Suspension lamp with diffused and direct down light. The high-relief hand-blown glass diffuser is produced inside a mould with special incisions of vertical and horizontal lines inside it. The diffuser is open downwards, guaranteeing direct light onto the underlying surface, which adds to the suffused light that transpires through the matt glass. A matt transparent injection-moulded polycarbonate ring nut is incorporated into the glass. Matt transparent injection-moulded polycarbonate lamp holder support. Stainless steel suspension cable and transparent electrical cable. Ceiling canopy with galvanised metal bracket and glossy white batch-dyed ABS cover. In the version with built-in LED, the mount is a module fitted with a COB affording superior lighting technology performance levels: excellent colour rendering, providing a warm, intense and emotional light in addition to a top-rate consumption/efficiency ratio. Also available in the dimmable version, with the following possible configurations: On-Off /Push/DALI.

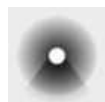
